

DOG LICENSING

Licensing of dogs, as required by State statute, must take place each January. A notice is published in the NJ Herald at that time and it is the responsibility of any resident owning a dog (or dogs) to license their pets. The duration of the rabies vaccination must cover ten months of the year that the license is issued. A valid certificate of rabies vaccination is required as well as a neutering certificate if that be the case. Any dog which has attained the age of seven months is required to be licensed in Fredon Township.

Owners of unlicensed dogs will be charged a late fee of \$5.00 per month, per dog after January 31st. **ANY DOG OWNERS WHO HAVE NOT LICENSED THEIR DOGS BY JUNE 30TH WILL RECEIVE A SUMMONS TO APPEAR IN COURT.** The dog licensing official is Tara Pellegrino and can be reached at 973-383-7025, Ext. 31.

PLEASE USE THIS APPLICATION TO OBTAIN A DOG LICENSE

Dog licenses must be renewed by January 31st of each year. Please submit the following:

1. Proof of rabies vaccination valid through November 1st and proof of neutering.
2. Check payable to Fredon Township for **\$11.00** (neutered) or **\$14.00** (non-neutered).
3. **Self-addressed stamped envelope must be included.**
