

Household Hazardous Waste Days

June 3rd & November 4th

Dispose of lead & oil based paints, thinners, pool chemicals, mercury, lubricants, chlorine, driveway sealer, fluorescent bulbs, household batteries and more.

Electronics Recycling Days

July 22nd, & October 14th

Includes computers, printers, cell phones, televisions, VCR's DVD & CD's, fax & copiers, radios & stereos, etc.

Limits: Up to 5 units per vehicle.

JCP&L Storm Update

During significant storm events JCP&L secures any known hazards (downed wires for example) first – usually by sending out Hazard Responders to keep the area clear. They are not trained to make repairs. They are there to help keep the public safe until repairs can be made.

When major storms occur, JCP&L works to restore customers as follows:

- Priority is given to hospitals, police and fire departments and other critical facilities.
- First repairs are made to transmission lines and substations that supply power to the local system.
- Next we make repairs that restore the largest number of customers-this is the fastest way to restore all customers.
- JCP&L understands that customers with well water face additional challenges when power is out. Stock up on drinking water and fill bathtubs in advance of storms.
- If necessary, information about locations for free water and ice locations will be provided.

Please be advised that repairs to the electric system are prioritized by the number of customers WITHOUT electricity. So the more customers who call in, the better and faster your chances are for your power to be restored. Please don't assume that others have already called in the outage!!

Bulk Pick-up 2017

Bulk pick-up will be provided only on the following dates in 2017:

May 18th
October 19th

Bulk Pickup is provided monthly for all residential dwellings located on roads regularly serviced by garbage haulers.

All Bulk pickup will be on **THURSDAY** on the **dates designated**. Items may be put out as early as the Sunday before the bulk pick-up date, but no sooner. It **ABSOLUTELY** must be put out the **NIGHT BEFORE** the pick-up date - pick-up begins at **5 AM**.

Bulk pick-up is **not** being picked up by your garbage hauler, so please do not **ASSUME** that if your garbage is still out there the bulk pick-up hauler has not been through the area.

HOUSEHOLD ITEMS ONLY!

Interior household bulk items such as stoves, refrigerators, furniture, carpets, etc., but not normal **household garbage or bagged garbage**. Building material, construction debris, outdoor items and tires will not be picked up! Bulk pick-up is not intended for whole-house clean-outs - please contact a hauler for a dumpster if needed.

**~If it is small enough to fit in a garbage bag or can
it is NOT bulk~**

Effective January 1, 2011, the following items may no longer be placed curbside for bulk pick-up: **Televisions, Monitors, Computers, and Laptop Computers. Additionally, effective on January 31, 2017 the following items have been added to the list of items prohibited to be placed curbside for bulk or regular pick-up as they may no longer go into the regular waste stream: **Printers, FAX machines and copiers**.**

The New Jersey Electronic Waste Management Act bans the disposal of these electronic devices and mandates that they be recycled. These items may be recycled at the following locations: SCMUA Collection Programs - Regular Operations (scale charges apply), Scheduled free annual recycling events, or New Jersey Manufacturers and Retailers.
